

From Sacramento (~79.15 miles):

- 1. Take I-80 W toward San Francisco
- 2. Take the exit onto CA-37 W toward San Rafael (~16.2 miles)
- 3. Turn right at Lakeville Hwy (~16.2 miles)
- 4. Turn left at Pine View Way (~0.3 miles)
- 5. Turn left at Cypress Dr (<0.1 miles)
- 6. Follow Cypress Dr to construction site entrance next to phonic ear.
- 7. Follow the construction road into the site and park near the trailers.

From San Francisco (~40.4 miles):

- 1. Take US-101 N
- 2. Take the CA-116 E exit toward Sonoma/Napa (~0.2 miles)
- 3. Turn left at CA-116/Lakeville Hwy (~0.9 miles)
- 4. Turn right at S McDowell Blvd (~0.6 miles)
- 5. Turn right at Cypress Dr (~0.2 miles)
- 6. Follow Cypress Dr to construction site entrance next to phonic ear.
- 7. Follow the construction road into the site and park near the trailers.

From Walnut Creek (~47.13 miles):

- 1. Take I-680 N over Benicia Bridge (partial toll road)
- Merge onto I-780 W via the exit on the left toward Benicia/Vallejo (~6.3 miles)
- 3. Merge onto I-80 E toward Sacramento (~3.0 miles)
- 4. Merge onto CA-37 W via EXIT 33 toward Napa (~16.2 miles)
- 5. Turn right onto Lakeville Hwy (~9.2 miles)
- 6. Turn left onto Pine View Way (~0.3 miles)
- 7. Turn left onto Cypress Dr (<0.1 miles)
- 8. Follow Cypress Dr to construction site entrance next to phonic ear.
- 9. Follow the construction road into the site and park near the trailers.


Directions to Pyramid Alehouse in Berkeley:
