LOCATION:

Giants Lot D - highlighted yellow (from the ballpark, Lot D is adjacent to 3rd St., one block away from the ballpark on your right hand side).

HOURS:

Giants Lot D opens 4 hours prior to game time for caterers & set-up, tailgaters allowed access 3 hours prior to game time.
